BYLAW NO. 2013 / 16

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN THE BEACH AREA

The Council of the Resort Village of Lumsden Beach (RVLB) in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The 'beach area' refers to all areas adjacent to the waterfront known as the Public Reserve. 'Parking' refers to any vehicle brought to a stop and remaining in the beach area. A 'designated officer' is an employee or agent of RVLB as appointed by RVLB Council.
2. RVLB shall determine where parking in the beach area is not allowed. Areas not allowed will be known either by signage or when parking inappropriately restricts the movement of other vehicles.
3. RVLB may take whatever actions necessary to remedy a contravention of this bylaw including ticketing and/or towing of vehicles.
4. No person shall fail to comply with an order made pursuant to this bylaw nor obstruct or interfere with any designated officer acting under the authority of this bylaw.
5. A designated officer who believes that a person has contravened this bylaw may serve Notice of Violation in an amount set out in the annual Schedule of Fees. Voluntary payment may be paid to the municipality within seven days thereby avoiding prosecution for the contravention.
6. Failure to pay the Notice of Violation may lead to prosecution and a fine as set out in the annual RVLB Schedule of Fees.
