BYLAW NO. 2013 / 3

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A PUBLIC NOTICE POLICY

The Council of the Resort Village of Lumsden Beach (RVLB) in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That RVLB Council shall provide appropriate notice to all ratepayers in regard to the following matters:
 1. The date, time and location of the annual ratepayers meeting.
 2. The method by which ratepayers can let it be known that they wish to appear at RVLB Council meetings.
 3. How and where to submit written information for consideration by RVLB Council.
 4. The date, time and location of RVLB sponsored recreation and social events.
 5. Planned disposition of municipal owned lands and/or buildings.
 6. Planned interim or permanent closing and/or blocking off a road, lane or walkway.
 7. Planned borrowing of money for municipal causes.
 8. Planned imposition of a special tax levy different than the annual Tax Notice.
 9. Amending or repealing an existing bylaw or creation of a new bylaw.
 10. Changes to the annual RVLB Schedule of Fees.
2. Appropriate notice to ratepayers can include any, but not necessarily all, of the following methods:
 1. Written notice mailed to ratepayers official address.
 2. Notice posted at the Municipal signboard in front of the Community Hall.
 3. Written notice emailed to the RVLB email list serve.
3. Appropriate notice is to be received or appear a minimum of seven days prior to the planned action being either considered or taking place.
