

## **RESORT VILLAGE OF LUMSDEN BEACH**

### **BYLAW NO. 22 - 2021**

#### **A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES (ATV)**

The Council of the Resort Village of Lumsden Beach (RVLB) in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows: That the Saskatchewan Provincial Government **ATV ACT** is the official legislation as it relates to the operation of ATV's in Saskatchewan. In order to provide direction to anyone operating an ATV at RVLB, the following is a summary of the ATV Act using portions of the Act that apply to RVLB. This summary does not override the actual Saskatchewan ATV Act.

1. At RVLB, ATV's are considered to be motorized vehicles often referred to as quads or side by sides, but do not include golf carts or two or three-wheeled vehicles. (Smaller sized children's ATV's may be used on private land, but are not allowed on RVLB municipal roads or trails.)
2. To operate an ATV in RVLB, a person must be 16 years of age, have mandatory training, a valid driver's license and the vehicle must be insured in accordance with The Saskatchewan Insurance Act (minimum of \$200,000 in third party liability insurance).
3. Passengers, other than the driver, can only ride on an ATV if it is an ATV designed with more than one seat.
4. To operate an ATV, the driver and any passengers must wear an approved helmet and appropriate protective eye wear.
5. Within the municipal boundaries of RVLB, ATV's can be driven on municipal roads and trails and within the beach parking area as it extends between the yellow control gates at each end of the parking area, but cannot be driven beyond the yellow gates or on the golf course.
6. When an ATV causes any loss, damage or injury, the person operating the ATV and/or the owner of the ATV at the time of the occurrence is liable for the loss, damage or injury, if it was caused by his negligence or improper conduct.
7. A person operating an ATV must operate:
  - \* With due care and attention;
  - \* At a speed that is safe and reasonable and never above the 25km/hr. RVLB speed limit;
  - \* With prescribed lights at night;
  - \* By yielding the right of way to all pedestrians;
  - \* By yielding the right of way to vehicles approaching from the right;
  - \* By passing on the right of oncoming vehicles;
  - \* To the left when passing a vehicle travelling in the same direction;
  - \* With seat belts when they are fitted and installed by the manufacturer.
