## A BYLAW AUTHORIZING COUNCIL TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MUTUAL AID AREA

The Council of the Resort Village of Lumsden Beach (RVLB) in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Whereas; provision is made in The Municipality Act enabling Council to enter into agreements with other municipalities for the furnishings of fire-fighting services and fire fighting equipment beyond urban boundaries, on any terms that may be agreed on; and

Whereas; the Council of RVLB deems it expedient to enter into an agreement for the purpose of establishing a Municipal Mutual Aid Area, to pool the resources of participating municipalities and improve their emergency response capabilities.
