BYLAW NO. 2021 - 22

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS REGARDING DOGS

The Council of the Resort Village of Lumsden Beach (RVLB) in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Preamble

The regulations within this Bylaw are directed at the owners of all dogs regardless of breed, size and degree of training. All dogs should be licensed, vaccinated and under the control of their owners. These regulations apply to all areas within the boundaries of the RVLB that are considered municipal property including municipal buildings, roadways, trails, public parks and the shoreline including Parcel A known as the 'beach'.

Regulations

1. All dogs are to be on a leash at all times when on municipal property with two exceptions:
 - a) There is an off leash area at the top of the valley wall encompassing RVLB Block 4 and that portion of Lumsden Beach Camp property leased by the RVLB. Owners of dogs in the off leash area are to have their dogs within sight at all times and must carry a leash at all times should their dog become a nuisance.
 - b) The public beach, officially known as Parcel A, is off limits to all dogs, whether on a leash or not, between 9:00am and 5:00pm daily. Dogs may be taken for an off leash swim outside of these times, but NEVER inside the public swimming area marked by buoys. Dog owners are encouraged to take their dogs to areas along the shoreline away from the main beach.
2. Dogs that are aggressive to humans and/or to other dogs should never be off leash.
3. If a dog defecates on any municipal or private property other than the premises of its owner, the owner of the dog shall remove the defecation immediately.
4. No owner of a dog shall permit the dog to bark or howl so as to create a nuisance at any time and in particular if the noise is at night
